The following draft of the rules further to amend the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which the Government of Kerala propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) and (k) of sub - section (2) of Section 28 of the Motor Vehicles Act,1988, is hereby published for general information as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act.

Notice is hereby given that the said draft rules will be taken up for consideration on or after thirty days from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette and that the objections or suggestions, if any, that may be received from any person in respect of the draft rules on or before the date specified above will be considered by the Government. Objections or suggestions if any in duplicate, shall be addressed to the Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram.

DRAFT RULES

- 1. Short Title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (Tenth Amendment) Rules, 2013.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of the rules. In rule 6 of the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989,-

- (i) in the first proviso for the word and figure "Standard IV" the word and figure "Standard VIII" shall be substituted;
- (ii) after the first proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely,"Provided further that the minimum educational qualification specifies in
 this rule shall not apply in the case of -
 - (a) Renewal of a driving license to drive a transport vehicle; or
 - (b) Addition of another class of transport vehicle to the driving license; already held before the commencement of the Kerala Motor Vehicles (Tenth Amendment) Rules, 2013";
- (iii) in the existing second proviso, the word "further" shall be substituted by the word "also".
