Sub:- Motor Vehicles Department – Disposal of unserviceable articles seized/confiscated vehicles lying idle in various departments-fixation of fair value-reg.

Ref:- 1 GO(Rt) No. 5740/13/Fin dated 11.07.13

2 Circular No. 10/2012 of the Transport Commissioner

Vide reference 2nd cited circular direction had been issued in connection with assessing the value of confiscated vehicle. Vide reference 1st cited Government have issued revised Government Order regarding the fixation of fair value of vehicles. Hence in suppression of direction issued vide Circular No. 10/12 following direction is issued on the basis of Government Order vide reference 1st cited.

While fixing the fair value of vehicles seized/confiscated, the depreciation pattern will be 20% of the purchase value for the first year and through up to 5th year it will depreciate at the rate of 20% of the depreciated value every year. From the 6th year up to 10th year the depreciation will be 10% of the depreciated value every year. After 10 years it will be treated as scrap and clause 2 (c) in Government Order G.O (MS) No. 223/2012/Fin dated 17.04.12 regarding scrap shall apply for disposal of the same. This circular shall come into force at once.
