ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, it was decided to implement 'FAST' (Fully Automated Services of Transport Department) Project as part of computerisation of the Motor Vehicles Department and also to collect service charges from the public for the services rendered under the said scheme. As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, Government was pleased to select M/s Electronics Corporation of India Limited (ECIL) as service provider for the implementation of FAST Project and approve the user fees recommended by the technical and monitoring committees of the FAST Project. As per Government Order read as 3rd paper above, sanction was accorded for collection of "User fees" with effect from 16.04.2007. The word "user fee" was modified as "Service Charges" and the rates of Service Charges for various services were fixed as per Government Order read as 4th paper above. Subsequently as per Government Order read as 5th paper above, Government have reduced the rate of service charges for certain services rendered through the office of Motor Vehicles Department.

The Transport Commissioner as per the letter dated 22.06.2010 read as 6th paper above, forwarded a fresh proposal for the reduction of Service charges in respect of a few services, considering the complaints received relating to higher service charges.

After examining the existing rates and the proposal submitted by the Transport Commissioner for reduction in service charges for certain services, Government are pleased to reduce the rate of service charges in respect of certain other services, mentioned in the statement appended herewith.

Detailed Statement regarding the rates of all services will be issued by the Transport Commissioner.
