S.R.O. No..... /2012.- WHEREAS, it has come to the notice of the Government of Kerala that accidents caused by the Tipper Lorries all over Kerala are increasing day by day;

AND WHEREAS, in Writ Appeal No.105/2012 filed against the Judgment in W.P.(C) No.30041/2011, the Honourable High Court of Kerala has observed that necessary power has to be invoked under section 115 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and necessary orders have to be issued invoking such power to impose restrictions in running tipper Lorries during the peak hours in the morning and evening all over the State;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala are satisfied that it is necessary, in public interest, to restrict the movement of tipper lorries/ vehicle equipped with tipping mechanism during peak hours in the morning and evening on the roads all over the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 115 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby order that tipper lorries/vehicles equipped with tipping mechanism shall not be operated on the roads all over Kerala during the time period from 8.00 a.m. to 10.00a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. and that appropriate traffic signs shall be erected under section 116 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 at suitable places all over Kerala to bring the above restriction to public notice.
