## **ORDER**

Ministry of Road Transport and Highways have issued many advisories to all States and Union Territories pertaining to extension of validity of documents related to Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989, considering the lock-down imposed during the pandemic time. Enforcement authorities have been advised to treat such documents valid till 31.10.2021.

In the above circumstances, Government are in receipt of a large number of representations for the extension of the validity of such documents which would expire on 31.10.2021 as the grim situation is not abated.

Therefore, Government have examined the matter in detail and found merits on the grievances and anxieties expressed by the stakeholders. Besides, there is likely to create heavy crowding at RTOs and various testing centres as the validity of many documents expires soon. In order to ensure adequate precautions, steps to be taken to mitigate the Covid pandemic, and also to alleviate grievances and difficulties faced by the stakeholders in the Transport sector, Government are pleased to order that the validity of the documents issued by the Transport Commissioner which would expire between 01.02.2020 to 31.10.2021 will further be extended up to 31.12.2021.
