## ORDER

As per paragraph 230 of the Budget Speech 2020 – 21, it was declared that the licence fee for Establishment of pollution testing stations will be increased to Rs.15,000/- as it was not increased for the last sixteen years.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to enhance the licence fee for establishing pollution testing station from Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) to Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with immediate effect. All other conditions regarding the validity and renewal of licence will be as specified in G O read as 5th paper above.
