ORDER

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Government of India has launched the Voluntary Vehicle Fleet Modernization Programme (V-VMP) or Vehicle Scrapping Policy which aims at creating an eco system to phase out unfit and polluting vehicles and promote recycling of vehicle scraping in an eco-friendly manner.

2. As per the G.O. read (2) above, Government of Kerala has decided to adopt the vehicle scrapping policy and decided to scrap 2506 vehicles which are more than fifteen years old at Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility on or before 28.02.2023. However Government could

not stick on to the decision due to some technical reasons.

- 3.Government of India has launched the Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2023-2024 by adding a special incentive scheme for scrapping of old vehicles.
- 4.Government after having examined the matter in detail,have identified the number of vehicles,which are more than fifteen years old, owned by the State Government, Kerala State Road Transport Corporation, Autonomous Bodies and Public Sector Undertakings.The number of vehicles are as follows.

5. The 2253 vehicles as specified in the table will be scrapped at the Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility established for the purpose.
