In exercise of the powers conferred on me under rule 85 of the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and in partial modification of Notification Nos. M.G. 1524/TC/62 dated 1-1-1963 and M.G. 15124/TC/1962 dated 15-3-1963, it is hereby notified the following:

Conductors of every stage carriage shall wear nameplate made up of either plastic or any clothing materials stitched to the pocket which exhibits Name and Badge number of the conductor. The size of the nameplate shall be 8×1.5 cm. 33/1276/2011/DTP.

The letters shall be in Malayalam or English (In block letters) in Black color on white background. The nameplate shall be displayed on their left chest above the pocket.

The Notification shall come into force at once.

#### **Explanatory Note**

(This does not form the part of the above notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

There are complaints about the bad behaviour of conductors of stage carriages. Exhibition of nameplate will help the public to identify the persons and they can file complaint against them if they are not behaving well. Thus, the number of such complaints can be reduced to great extent. This will also help to provide a more responsible public transportation system to the public.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
