S. R. O. No. 659/2016.—WHEREAS, a reciprocal agreement has already been entered into between the Government of Kerala and the Government of Karnataka in respect of road transport services on inter state routes as per Notification No. 10845/TB3/74/PW, dated 26th June, 1976 and published as S.R.O. No. 698/76 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 392 dated the 30th June 1976;

AND WHEREAS, the following four supplemental transport agreements to the main agreement were entered into between the Government of Karnataka and Government of Kerala, namely :—

1. Notification No. G.O. (P) 85/82/TF&P, dated 30th December, 1982 and published as S.R.O. No. 1593/82 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 973 dated the 31st December, 1982.
2. Notification No. G.O. (P) 42/92/PW&T, dated 14th May, 1992 and published as S.R.O. No. 584/1992 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 580 dated the 15th May, 1992.
3. Notification No. G.O. (P) 11/2005/Tran., dated the 7th June, 2005 and published as S.R.O. No. 596/2005 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1314 dated the 9th June, 2005.
4. Notification No. G.O.(P) 21/2009/Tran., dated the 6th February, 2009 and published as S.R.O. No. 121/2009 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 296 dated the 6th February, 2009;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala and the Government of Karnataka have agreed to enter into a further supplemental agreement under section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), for the purpose of operation of stage carriages on certain new inter-state routes and for operation of additional services on certain existing inter-state routes on single point tax and for the enhancement of quota of goods carriages of both the States on single point tax basis;

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala had published the draft supplemental inter-state agreement to be entered into between the Government of Kerala and the Government of Karnataka vide notification No. 15184/B2/2012/Tran., dated 18-5-2015 published in the Kerala Official Gazette dated 26-5-2015 for information of all persons likely to be affected inviting representations or suggestions if any within 30 days from the date of publication in the Official Gazette;

AND WHEREAS, the representations/suggestions in response to the draft notification 26-5-2015 were heard and considered by the Government on 31-7-2015;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (6) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby publish the following agreement arrived at between the Government of Kerala and Government of Karnataka, namely :—

FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL INTER-STATE AGREEMENT

This supplemental Reciprocal Transport Agreement is made on this the 10th day of February 2016 between the Governor of Kerala (hereinafter referred to as "Government of Kerala" which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors in office and assigns) represented by the Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government of Kerala on the one part and the Governor of Karnataka (hereinafter referred to as "Government of Karnataka" which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors in office and assigns) represented by the Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government of Karnataka on the other part subject to the other conditions already included in the previous agreements, it has been further agreed to by both the Government as follows:

1. Stage Carriages:—

- (a) The Stage Carriage Services in the inter-state route as shown in Annexure-A shall be exclusively operated by the State Transport Undertaking of Karnataka.
- (b) The Stage Carriage Services in the inter-state route as shown in Annexure-B shall be exclusively operated by the State Transport Undertaking of Kerala.
- (c) The number of round trips and buses as shown in Annexure-C operated by Karnataka State Transport Undertakings shall be increased as noted against each route.
- (d) Variation of existing routes operated by State Transport Undertakings of Karnataka given in column 2 of Annexure-D shall be varied as noted in column 10 to 16 against each route.
- (e) Details of additional services to be operated by the State Transport Undertakings of both States in connection with Fairs and Festival seasons shall be as shown in Annexure-E in addition to the existing provisions.
- (f) Additional services to be operated by the State Transport Undertakings of both States during summer season (March 15th to June 15th) every year shall be as shown in Annexure-F, in addition to the existing provisions.

- (g) The State Transport Undertakings of both States would operate additional services during weekends (Friday to Monday) every weekend to cater to the needs of the traveling public on the routes as shown in Annexure-G.

Both the State Governments agreed for all the above said services by both the State Transport Undertakings from Annexure A to G.

2. Modification of routes due to the ban on night traffic in Bandipur forests:—

In view of the ban on night traffic in Bandipur forests, the night services (both regular stage carriages and special/additional services) of the State Transport Undertakings of both States, operated to various places via Mysore, Nanjangud, Gundulpet, Sultanbathery, Kalpetta may be operated via Mysore, Hunsur, Gonikoppa, Ponnampet, Kutta, Manandwadi and Kalpetta. Similarly, the services operated via Mysore, Nanjangud, Gundulpet, Bandipur, Karnataka-Tamil Nadu State Border, Gudalur, Kerala State Border, Perinthalmanna and Thrissur may be operated via Mysore, Hunsur, Gonikoppa, Ponnampet, Kutta, Mananthawadi, Kalpetta, Kozhikode and Thrissur.

Both the State Governments agreed for all the above said change of routes as there is a ban on the movement of vehicles through Bandipur Forest area.

3. Permit for Private Operators:—

Both the State Governments decided not to include private operators in the Agreement as the routes mentioned in the list of the private operators are well served by the services of both the State Transport Undertakings.

4. Enhancing quota for Goods Carriages:—

Both the State Governments decided to enhance quota of goods carriage permits from the present 3000 to 5000 for each State (increase by 2000 to each State).

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to bring out main purport.)

Inter State Road Transport between the States of Kerala and Karnataka is regulated by the Inter State Reciprocal Agreement executed by the Government of both the States with effect from 1st July, 1976. As per clause VIII of the said agreement, any clause in that Agreement or Appendices thereto may be amended for a new one added to it at any stage after mutual agreement between the State Governments. In pursuance to the same supplementary agreements had been executed on 1st December, 1982, 4th February 1992, 7th June, 2005 and 25th August 2008 respectively. Both the State Governments felt the necessity for operation of new routes, extension of existing routes and operation of additional services in respect of Stage Carriages and Goods Carriages on inter-state routes. The proposal to enter into an agreement between the States of Kerala and Karnataka has been published under Notification No. 15184/B2/2012/Tran. dated 18th May, 2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1277 dated 26-5-2015. Accordingly both State Governments have executed a supplementary agreement for the above purpose. Now, the agreement has to be published as provided in sub-section (6) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988). Hence this notification.
