Government from the Association of Physically Handicapped that face con-design may be extended to the Handicapped in Stage Carriages other that those build by the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation also:

And whereas, the Government consider it necessary to extend fore con-cession to the handicapped in stage extringes other than those named by the Recala State Road Transport Corporation;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (i) of sub-section (1) of section 43 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (Central Are 4 of 1939). Government of Kerala hereby issue the following directions to the published to fonification No. 54437/M1/25/PW & T direct the 2nd November, 1935 published in the Kerals Garctic Extraordinary No. 211 dated the

2nd November, 1985 and the objections and suggestions having been considered in consultation with the State Transport Authority, Kerala after giving the representatives of the interests affected an opportunity of being heard as required by the proviso to the said sub-section, namely:—

#### DERECTIONS

The State Transport Authority shall fix the rates of concessions for traveiling in the stage carriages other than those owned by the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation in respect of physically handicapped persons permanently residing in the Kerala State subject to the following conditions namely:—

- 1. The physically handicapped person, shall be allowed concession in tarcs in stage carriages other than those owned by the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation for a distance not exceeding 40 kilometres for a single journey.
- The concession shall be at the rate of 70% of the prescribed fare an production of identity cards issued by Regional Transport Officers.
- Dec. For The identity cards may be issued on the basis of the Certificate of a hiedical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon in the Orthopaedic Branch of a recognised hospital certifying that the applicant has less than 50% (Fifty per cent) disability.
  - Note—The term "recognised hospitals" means Government hospitals or hospitals recognised by the Government for the purpose of lauling continents, to the physically handicapped persons by the Social Welfare Department.
- 4. Application form (Appendical) may be obtained free of cost from Regional Transport Office, Sub Regional Transport Office and Unit Office and the same may be submitted to the officers mentioned in para 2 above duly filled in and certified by the Medical Officer as indicated in para 3 above.
- 5. A passport size photograph of the applicant will be affixed in the application in the column provided therein and duly attested by the Certifying Medical Officer. Another copy of the passport size photograph shall be produced separately for affixing in the Identity Card.
- 6. Identity Card once issued shall be valid for a period of 3 years from the date of asset, which can be renewed after the period of expiry if and when, the applicant produces a certificate from the Medical Officer that he continues to be a handwapped person having 50% disability.

- 7. Loss of Identity card should be reported to the issuing Authori:
- 8. Duplicase Identity Card may be issued if the Card is lost or damage during the period of validity. An amount of Rs. 2 (Rupees two only) will t realised from the party as fee for the duplicate Card.
- 9. Change of residence of Card holders shall be reported promptly: the issuing authority, so as to enable him to make necessary corrections in the record.
- 10. The issuing authorities shall maintain a Myriets in Bip or sector appended as Appendix-II and keep correct account of Identity of the form
